I just thought you would enjoy reading about my experience adopting a cat from the Animal Refuge League in Westbrook.

I adopted "Ginger" (new name - she was called Venus at the League) on December 5, 2006. She was a year and a half old at that time. I was without a cat for more than a year after my cat of twenty years died. I was also alone, my husband had passed away a month before in November.

I decided to walk Ginger if she would take to a collar and a lead - and she did. I know it must look odd seeing a cat being walked around here in the country where I live. But I decided I would not let her out without a lead because I live off a very busy Route 302.

I also own and operate a gallery (Hole In The Wall Studioworks in Raymond) and Ginger has become the "Gallery Cat".
