I always add that we got Molly and Archie from the Animal Refuge League, because I want people to see how great an adopted dog can be.

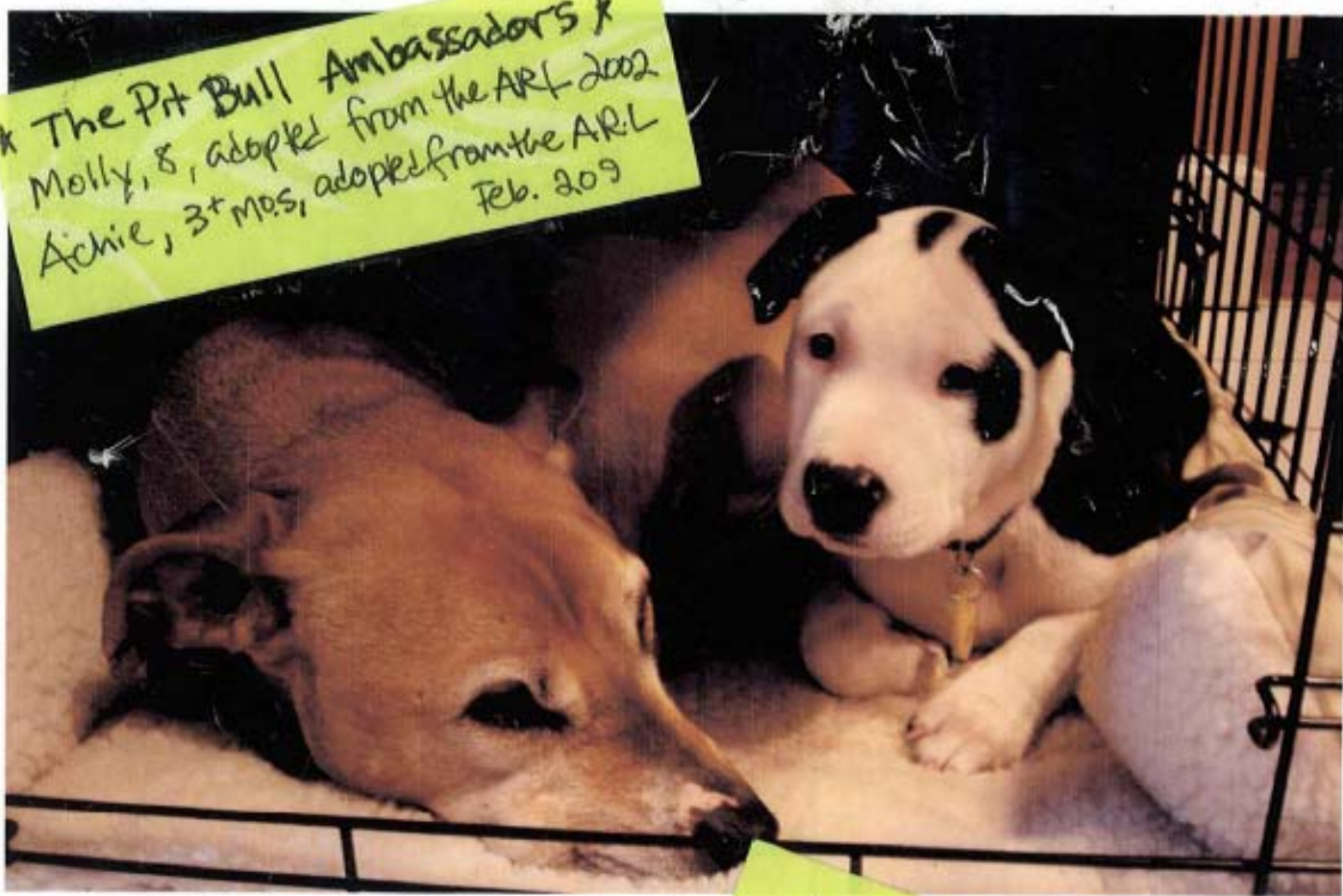
